Media Release

The Australian Chinese Charity Foundation held its annual fundraising dinner on Saturday 26th October 2024 at the Eight Restaurant in Haymarket.

The highlight of this dinner is the announcement and cheque presentation for a total sum of \$141,500 to 20 successful Community Projects Grant 2024-25 recipients.

The theme for the 2024-25 Community Projects Grant, *Let's talk about mental health*, aims to fund community initiatives that support people who are affected by mental illness. We received a strong number of expressions of interest from services across Australia.

While evaluating the applications, the Assessment Committee took into consideration the project's relevance, the applicant's experience in delivering projects, as well as the project's ability to address gaps of service, and disproportional challenges faced by disadvantaged groups such as First Nations people, people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, young people and people in rural and remote areas.

The 20 successful projects will be delivered in 2025 to raise awareness about mental illness, reduce mental illness stigma, support families/carers of people experiencing mental illness and provide peer support and education on mental illness, in metropolitan and regional NSW, South Australia and Victoria.

We take this opportunity to thank all organisations who submitted applications and express our admiration for their tireless effort to ensure those affected by mental illness are supported.
